Character Breakdown:

- Sky Masterson (age 20's - early 30's): A well respected gambler in his mid to late 20's. A handsome love interest who has spent his life avoiding the 'big heart throb'. Baritone: B-E Flat
- Sara Brown (age 20's): a Salvation Army officer who tries to convince those who drink or gamble to change their ways and refuses to fall in love with one. Soprano: B-High F
- Nathan Detroit (age 30's - early 40's): The anxious organizer of the all gambler's locations, and "long" time fiancé of Miss Adelaide. Baritone/Tenor: D-High F
- Miss Adelaide (age 30's): The star attraction at the Hot Box, and is constantly fighting her psychological cold from never being married to Nathan. Alto: A-D
- Nicely-Nicely Johnson: Fellow gambler and one of Nathan's right hand men. High Tenor D Flat-High C
- Benny Southstreet: Fellow gambler and one of Nathan's right hand men. Tenor
- Rusty Charlie: A neighborhood gambler. Tenor
- Arvide Abernathy (age 50's or higher): Sara's Grandfather and fellow Salvation Army officer. Baritone: D-High F

- General Cartwright: A stuffy Salvation Army Matron. Mezzo-Soprano: E-High A or C
- Harry the Horse: A neighborhood gambler
- Big Jule: A big wig gambler from Chica-gah
- Angie the Ox: A neighborhood gambler
- Lt Brannigan: The Neighborhood cop who is trying to chase down Nathan Detroit's newest dice game location.
- Joey Biltmore: Owner of the Biltmore Garage, one of Nathan's choice locations to use.
- Mimi: one of Miss Adelaide's fellow dancers at the Hot Box.
- Master of Ceremonies: The MC at the Hot Box.
